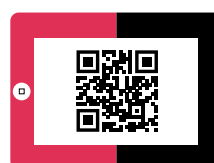

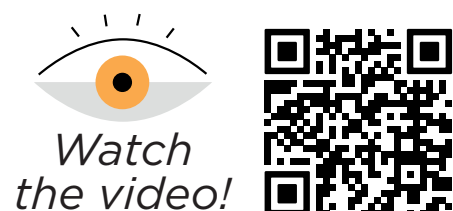

The **Professional Bachelor's Degree in Construction and Environmental and Territorial Management at the Polytechnic of Bari** is aimed at training graduate surveyors with a high-level three year professionalisation course. This includes practical activities developed at institutions and companies from within the field who are closely involved in course activities.



EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The aim of the course is to enable students to develop high-level professional skills, primarily in three different areas:

- **Building, urban planning and environment** where graduates can apply their knowledge in areas such as design, project management and accounting, testing and safety coordination;
- **Appraisal and assessment activities**, which enable graduates to work in areas such as market value estimation of real estate and technical-legal assistance, essential in judicial and extrajudicial disputes and in public or private procurement contracts;
- **Geomatic and cadastral activities** where the graduate can apply acquired skills to surveying territory and built environments and tracing infrastructural works such as roads, hydraulics and railway tracks.

Graduate surveyors act as a bridge between surveyors and engineers, with the

opportunity to benefit from immediate entry into the workforce and to capitalise on a learning process expressly aimed at providing university-level skills which can be implemented immediately



Location

All course lectures are held at the **Bari campus**.



Duration

Expected course completion time is **3 years**.



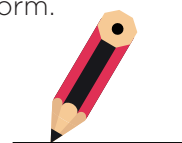
Language

All lessons, seminars, and laboratories are held in **italian**.



Admission

Admission is subject to students passing the specific selection test, managed by Polytechnic of Bari on the Teams platform.



SKILLS

The degree allows for registration with the **College of Surveyors and Graduate Surveyors**.

The course is carried out in accordance with European standards and in close collaboration with the Provincial College of Surveyors and Graduate Surveyors of Bari and Barletta-Andria-Trani, with the aim of creating a professional figure who can rapidly enter the workforce.

The European Union has reiterated the importance of professional programmes in the framework of post-secondary education and has declared its intention to boost these using **NEXT GENERATION funds**.



PROFESSIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Graduate surveyors operate in both the public and private sectors in areas such as:

- Environmental protection;
- Assessment, recovery and upgrading of real estate and infrastructural heritage, design/implementation of eco-compatible buildings;
- Measurement, presentation and protection of land and built environments;
- Management and coordination of construction sites;
- Safety and health in workplaces, schools, and private homes;
- Renewable energy sources and energy efficiency;
- Design/management of civil and environmental engineering projects with non-specific complexities;
- Technical support in the design/implementation of civil and environmental work projects;
- Management of technical-administrative procedures within public administrations.

Employment opportunities are commonly available with:

- Construction companies;
- Professional offices and civil works design companies;
- Professional offices dealing with the environment, land control and defense, waste management, and environmental and energy resources;
- Public offices for the design, planning, management and control of urban and territorial systems;
- Companies, bodies, consortia, and agencies operating in the management and control of project and service systems;
- Enterprises;
- Real estate appraisal companies.
